The inaugural meetings of the Governance Committee laid the foundation for the Registry initiative with engaged discussions taking place around patient knowledge and expectations of care. The Shoulder Topic Expert Group held an inaugural meeting with consensus towards concentrating on symptoms of shoulder pain, stiffness and instability.



The new branding reflects the aim of building a healthy community through innovative data capture, with an opportunity to develop personalized patient treatment plans and cutting-edge research that will guide the direction of bone and joint health in Alberta.
